About the Position: The Musconetcong Watershed Association is a non-profit conservation organization located in Asbury, New Jersey. MWA is seeking candidates for a position for the spring and summer of 2017. The outdoor supervisor will assist in caring for the native plantings at the River Resource Center and nearby riparian sites including:

- coordinating volunteers for outdoor work
- preparing plants and materials for the MWA's spring native plant sale
- weeding and mulching in the native plant beds around the RRC
- watering newly planted shrubs, perennials and deck planters
- planting perennials, grasses, shrubs and tree seedlings on the property
- planting willow whips & stakes in riparian buffers
- pruning and monitoring plants for diseases
- beaver-proofing young trees with wire and stakes
- removing invasives
- repairing plant labels and marking plants in the beds
- cleaning and filling bird feeders
- monitoring nestboxes
- supervising mowing of paths around and through the meadow
- assisting with maintenance on RRC River Trail

Qualifications: Qualified applicants will have had experience with native plants or will be working towards a degree in biology, botany, ecology, environmental policy or a related field. Applicants must be comfortable working outdoors and be physically able to do all gardening tasks, including some lifting and carrying.
